COMPLETION OF ENROLLMENT & TUITION CHECKLIST:

The following items must be completed before your child(ren) will be allowed to attend classes for the 2008-2009 school year

- Book Fee Due by August 15**
- \$150.00 per K3, K4 & K-5 student
- \$225.00 per 1st thru 5th grade student
- \$250.00 per 6th thru 8th grade student
- \$300.00 per 9th thru 12th grade student
- P.E. Fee due by August 15th (Required for 6th-10th Grades)**
- \$50.00 flat rate to include two P.E. uniforms
- Accidental Insurance Fee due by August 15th**
- \$25.00 per family mandatory- No deductible, 100% coverage up to \$25,000 per school injury
- Agenda Fee due by August 15th (Student Handbook Organizer mandatory for 1st thru 12th)**
- \$20.00 Fee
- Year Book Fee due by August 15th:**
- K-3 thru 5th: \$30 6th thru 12th: \$35
- School Enhancement Fee due by April 1st**
- \$500.00 per family
- Supply Pack Fee (refer to supply pack form for \$ amount)**
- (Mandatory K3, K4 & K5 – optional 1st thru 5th)
- Vision & Hearing Screening Fee due by August 15th for the following grades K4, K5, 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7th**
- \$10.00 –This is required by the State of Texas
- Acanthosis Nigricans Screening due by August 15th for the following grades 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7th**
- \$5.00-This screening is for diabetes in children. No blood is drawn. This is required by the State of Texas.
- Spinal Screening Fee due by August 15th (6th and 9th Grades Only)**
- \$5.00 – This is required by the State of Texas.
